# **Primary Care Hubs**

#### We now have hubs open at the following sites:

Stratton – Ruby Medical Launceston Medical Centre Liskeard Community Hospital Saltash – St Barnabus Hospital Callington – Tamar Valley Health – Recently opened 02/12/2024 Bodmin Community Hospital St Austell – Carlyon Road Hub Truro Health Centre Falmouth Health Centre – Recently opened 02/12/2024 Helston Community Hospital St Ives – Stennack Surgery Mount Hawke Surgery Newquay Hospital Redruth – Leatside Surgery

We currently have secured funding until March 2025 and looking likely to continue well into next year.

The hubs provide additional appointments for people who present on the day with minor illness symptoms. Practices can direct some of their patients to attend these hubs if they meet the set criteria.

We have already received lots of positive feedback from the clinicians who have worked shifts at the Primary Care Hubs. Practices will refer patients to the hubs to ease pressures, offering 15 minute appointments with regular catch up slots throughout the shift.

You as the clinician get to choose the dates you would like to work and importantly, the time and location that suits you......it's as easy as that.

## A SUMMARY OF WHAT OUR STAFF BANK DOES

This mailer is delivered to you by the staff bank team at Kernow Health. Here's some clarification on our role:

### WHAT WE DO:

- act as a hub where practices can post jobs
- send a weekly mailer. Staff Bank Co-ordinator, Lisa Rowe, will post updated jobs and information every Monday. If you are interested in a shift, you should email Lisa who will put you in touch with the practice or liaise with the practice on your behalf.
- offer a HR check. This can make it easier for practices to employ you e.g. with short notice. This is non-essential, and you can still book a job without a Kernow Health HR check and organise this direct with the practice instead
- provide an inclusive community of practice for locum GPs, and also for those who are interested in locum work, or simply wish to be included in a community of practice (eg new to practice GPs, International Medical Graduates)
- connect doctors for peer support, CPD, social and wellness

### WHAT WE DON'T DO:

- charge any fees to locum or practice (this service is funded by NHS England)
- set or cap your rate you discuss and agree this directly with the practice

we don't employ you – you are self-employed as is usual for locum work and your contract is direct with the practice
