The knowledge and skills acquired through the skills bootcamp align with **national clinical competencies at Level 3**. The course will cover **essential clinical skills** required by primary care providers such as:

- Demonstrating professional practice
- Undertaking physiological measurements including recognition and escalation of the deteriorating Adult (RESTORE2)
- Venepuncture
- ECG
- NHS Checks
- Diabetic foot checks
